### **FIVE PRINCIPLES FROM FIRST PETER**

- Written during persecution 1,940 years ago
- · Constant threat of violence
- Emperor Nero killing, torturing Christians
- · Christians blacklisted from employment
- 15 times Peter refers to suffering
