Read Proverbs 14:18–35. Remember, the Proverbs are observations about what Solomon sees happening in the world around him. Some Proverbs, like 14:20, may surprise you. This Proverb is not recommending that you shun the poor; in fact, the next verse suggests that we are blessed if we help the needy! These are observations about human nature.

Read Proverbs chapter 15. This chapter speaks frequently of three themes: Pride, plans, and words.

Read Proverbs chapter 18. This chapter has themes we haven't seen much in Proverbs so far, including unfriendliness (verse 1); justice (verses 5 and 17); diligence (verse 9). One of my favorites is verse 17. Always remember this when people come to you with their complaints or stories!
