Daily Meditations

Monday

We all desire to live a life that makes an impact on the world around us. What did you learn this past weekend that will help you make a positive impact on the people around you?

Look at Matthew 23:4–10. What does Jesus criticize the religious leaders for?

How does this relate to Peter's advice to leaders?

Pray for your leaders today. Ask God to help them be the humble, servant leaders he desires. You are a leader, too, in some way: As a parent, spouse, co-worker, student, friend. You are leading someone somewhere. Pray that God will help you lead in the way Peter describes.

Tuesday

Read 1 Peter 5:1–3. How does serving help you lead a significant life?

What situations are you facing where you can...

- Choose devotion over duty?
- Choose giving over getting?
- Choose influence over being in control?

Thank God today for the example Jesus set for you in serving others. Ask God to help you today to choose devotion, giving, and influence in the situations you will face.

Wednesday

Read Philippians 2:3, Colossians 3:12, and 1 Peter 5:5–6. The principle of staying humble can be so difficult to actually practice in daily life! What are some aspects of humility you see described in these verses?

Twice in these verses we're told to "clothe yourselves in humility". What does that mean, practically, to you? How do you live that out in your daily life?

Recall a time when you responded to a situation with humility and another time when vou responded with pride. What difference did responding with humility make?

Ask God today to help you stay humble and apply what you studied in His word todav.

Thursday

Read Matthew 6:31–34 and 1 Peter 5:7. These verses don't just tell you to stop worrying; they give you a good reason to stop worrying. What is it?

What's the biggest obstacle you face in giving your cares to God?

When you stop worrying, how does that help you live a life of greater impact?

What worries are you currently clinging to?

Take some time today to cast those anxieties on God. Because He cares for you! Ask Him to guide you and then leave your anxious feelings with Him. Thank Him for His unending care for you.

Friday

Read 1 Peter 5:1-7 again. What has been the most significant lesson from this passage for you this week?

What changes have you made in your life because of what you've learned?

How does the example of Jesus Christ illustrate to you what servant leadership is, and how it can change the world?

Thank God today for the practical help you receive from His word. Ask Him to help you apply what you've learned.
