### FACTS ABOUT STORMS

- Storms are "When you face trials..." James 1:2
- Storms are \_\_\_\_\_\_ "Without warning, a furious storm came up..."
- Storms are "He sends the rain on the righteous **and** the unrighteous." Matt. 5:45

### TRUTHS FOR STORMS

#### 1. Jesus is

"Then He (Jesus) got into the boat and His disciples followed Him." vs. 23

"Fear not, for I have redeemed you. I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters. I will be with you, and when vou pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you!" Isaiah 43:1-2

#### 2. Jesus

"The disciples said to Him, 'Teacher, don't You care if we drown?" Mark 4:38

"Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you!" 1 Peter 5:7

"The (believer) will not be overthrown by evil circumstances. **God's constant care** of him will make a deep impression on all who see it. He does not fear bad news, nor live in dread of what may happen. For he is settled in his mind that **God will take care of him**. That is why he is not afraid but can calmly face his foes." Ps. 112:6-9 (LB)

#### 3. Jesus is in

"Jesus got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, 'Peace! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm." Mark 4:39

"Sovereign Lord, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for You." Jer. 32:17

"The men were amazed and asked. 'What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him." Matt. 8:27
