# 1. SYMPTOMS: The Problem of God's Seeming Absence

• I feel like praying does no good

When I was in distress, I sought the Lord; at night I stretched out untiring hands and my soul refused to be comforted. I remembered you, O God, and I groaned. I mused, and my spirit grew faint. *Psalm 77:2–3* 

I can't sleep

You kept my eyes from closing; I was too troubled to speak. Psalm 77:4

• I dwell on how good things used to be

I thought about the former days, the years of long ago; I remembered my songs in the night. *Psalm 77:5–6a* 

• I fear things will never get better

Will the Lord reject **forever**? Will he **never** show his favor again? Has his unfailing love vanished **forever**? Has his promise failed **for all time**? Has God forgotten to be merciful? Has he in anger withheld his compassion? Selah. *Psalm* 77:7–9a

## 2. SOLUTION: The Power of Positive

Then I thought, "To this I will appeal: the years of the right hand of the Most High." **I will remember** the deeds of the LORD; yes, **I will remember** your miracles of long ago. I will meditate on all your works and consider all your mighty deeds." *Psalm* 77:10–12



## 3. SECRET: The Principle of \_\_\_\_\_

[Joshua:] "Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder... to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' tell them... **These stones are to be a memorial** to the people of Israel forever." *Joshua 4:5*–7

Then Samuel **took a stone and set it up** between Mizpah and Shen. He named it Ebenezer, saying, "Thus far has the LORD helped us." *1 Samuel 7:12* 

Monumental faith sets up reminders of great acts of God, and in times of discouragement, looks to those monuments for hope!

# **Building Monuments**

#### How to use this:
