#### 1. Faithful to \_\_\_\_\_

When the people saw that Moses was so long in coming down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said, “Come, make us gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us out of Egypt, we don’t know what has happened to him.” Exodus 32:1

4. Please read Lamentations 3:22-23 and Isaiah 43:18-19. What can hold you back from embracing the “fresh starts” that God faithfully provides? Where do you need to step into a new start that God is providing? Who in your life could you encourage with the truth of God’s faithfulness to begin again in our lives?
