TWO WAYS TO SEE MY RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD:

Elements of this relationship:

- "Job description" religion

Elements of this relationship:

1. NEW _____

So in Christ Jesus you are all **children of God** through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. Gal. 3:26,27

2. NEW _____

There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, neither male and female, for **you are all one in Christ Jesus**. Gal. 3:28

3. NEW

If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and **heirs** according to the promise. Gal. 3:29

What I am saying is that as long as an heir is underage, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. The heir is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his father. So also, when we were underage, we were in slavery under the elemental spiritual forces of the world. But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to **redeem** those under the law, that we might receive **adoption** to sonship. Gal. 4:1-5

4. NEW _____

Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the **Spirit** who calls out, **"Abba, Father."** Gal. 4:6

SO WHAT?

So **you are no longer a slave**, but **God's child**; and since you are his child, God has made you also an **heir**. Gal. 4:7

DAILY MEDITATIONS

MONDAY Read Galatians 3:26-27. Do you tend to see yourself as a slave of God, or as a friend and child of God? Read Galatians 4:6 and John 15:15. According to these verses, how does God want you to see yourself? How would your life be different if you truly saw yourself as the beloved child of God at all times? According to John 1:12, how do we become children of God? Thank God today for calling you his child rather than his slave – and ask Him to help you remember to see yourself that way as well! *Pray that prayer of grace at the end of the notes!*

TUESDAY Does it somehow see too familiar, too fresh, to call God "Abba", meaning "daddy"? I have struggled with it myself! But there's no mistaking the clear teaching of Scripture. Read Mark 14:36, Romans 8:15, and Galatians 4:6 again. Do these verses make you feel comfortable or uncomfortable? Why? *Today thank God that he desires to be known this personally by you!*

WEDNESDAY Read Luke 15:11-32. You probably know this as the Parable of the Prodigal Son. But it's also the story of the Older Son. What do his comments in verse 29 reveal about the way he saw his relationship with his Dad? What attitude did this concept produce? Do you think this infects Christians today? What is the father's response? *Today thank God that you are not just an employee slaving for a boss; by His grace, you are an heir! Pray that prayer of grace at the end of the notes.*

THURSDAY Today meditate on these Scriptures: 1 John 3:1-3 and Galatians 4:7. What truth do these verses communicate? Why is this sometimes difficult to believe? How does this belief "purify" you? *Again today pray that prayer of grace at the end of the notes – of course you don't need to pray it word-forword; use your own language.*

FRIDAY Read 1 John 5:1,2; Ephesians 5:1,2; Colossians 3:12. If I am God's beloved child, how does that change my behavior toward others, according to these verses? Ask God to help you see how to treat other believers as brothers and sisters, and how to reach out to those still lost.

SATURDAY Read Galatians 3:28,29. Ask God to help TLC to be a beacon of this kind of Christian unity! Please pray for the weekend services as we celebrate the 125th birthday of Twin Lakes Church!
