MEMORY VERSE: This week's memory verse: He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. Philippians 1:6b

DAILY MEDITATIONS

MONDAY Read 1 Samuel 7:10-13. What encouraged you in last weekend's message? In this passage Samuel calls the monument he built "Ebenezer", meaning "The LORD helped us". How can it be helpful in times of discouragement for you to remember how God has helped you in the past? Think of a time God helped you when times were difficult. How can you build an "Ebenezer" to remind you of God's faithfulness in that event? Thank God for His grace to you in your past.

TUESDAY Read 2 Corinthians 9:8-15. Where are you experiencing need right now? What do these verses tell you about God's gracious provision for your needs? What do these verses say about how we are to give to others? How do you believe God is calling you to be generous, because He has been generous to you? (Generosity is not only about giving money. You can also be generous with time, encouragement, prayers...) Thank God today for His faithful provision for your needs, and for the needs of Twin Lakes Church.

WEDNESDAY Philippians 4:10-20. What do these verses tell you about God's gracious provision for your needs? What can you learn from this passage about being content? Thank God today for His faithful provision for your needs, and for the needs of Twin Lakes Church.

THURSDAY Read 2 Corinthians 1:8-11. Seeming delays on God's part can be very difficult. What encouragement did you receive last weekend about God's timing? How can the story of God's provision through the history of TLC encourage you? In what circumstance are you struggling to understand God's timing? What would it look like for you to trust God's timing in that circumstance? Ask God to help your faith in God's timing to grow.

FRIDAY Read Galatians 6:9,10. This comes at the end of Paul's long letter emphasizing that we are saved by grace, not works. God's unconditional gracious love to us is our motivation for giving to others, not any sort of "brownie point" system. Do you ever feel discouraged in doing good works? Why? What does this verse promise? We may never see our harvest here - harvests always happen in other seasons - but we can rest in this promise from God!

SATURDAY Read Galatians 4:8-20 to prepare for this weekend's continuing series in Galatians. Please pray for this weekend's services—that God will be glorified and the services will be effective! Thanks!
