HOME WITH THE LORD

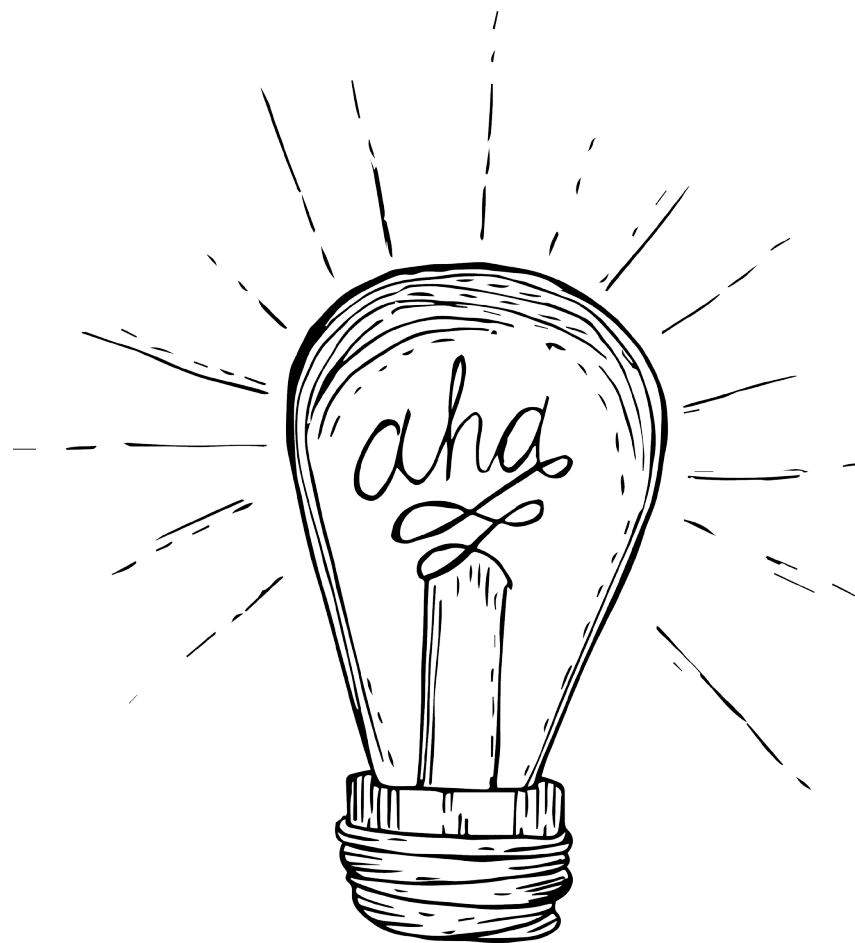

Then he gave them to the disciples to distribute to the people. They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over. *Luke 9:16b-17*

...he distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten. *John 6:11b-13*

DAILY MEDITATIONS

MONDAY

Please read John 6:6-14. What is one thing from last weekend's sermon that stands out to you? Why? Which of the three reasons (guilt, feeling overwhelmed, or fear) do you struggle most with when it comes to offering your "five loaves and two fishes" to God? Thank God today for His power. *Thank Him for the fact that He is the same God who fed the five thousand today. Talk to Him about your struggles with surrendering your loaves and fishes to Him.*

TUESDAY

Please read Luke 9:10-17. In what way do you see God providing the disciples opportunity to be part of the miracle He was about to perform? What do you imagine the disciples' thoughts/feelings were? How have you seen God open doors for you to help others? What is motivating you (or causing you to hesitate) when it comes to stepping out to serve others? *Thank God today that He calls us. Thank Him for working through imperfect people (like us!). Pray for the peace and faith to step out and serve in the opportunities God is giving you.*

WEDNESDAY

Please read Mark 6:30-44. What does God provide for the disciples to prepare for the miracle? What "loaves and fishes" has God provided for you to offer up for a miracle? *Thank God today for His provision. Pray for a willingness to let go of what He's given you in order to see Him use it for a miracle.*

THURSDAY

Please read Matthew 14:13-21. What stands out to you about God's multiplying power in this miracle? How can knowing God multiplies what He provides help you have the courage to step out and serve? *Thank God today for His power. Pray that you will see His multiplying power in your life.*

FRIDAY

Please read Hebrews 13:7-8. When you look at the disciples' reactions, what type of faith do you see that you want to imitate? Knowing that the Jesus who fed the five thousand is the same Jesus who is with you is pretty amazing! How can that truth give you hope today? How can it give you courage? *Thank God for His unchanging nature. Pray that your faith will be an example for those who are watching you. Ask God to help you live with confidence in the truth of His unchanging love and power.*

SATURDAY

Please read Psalm 54:4. Thank God today that He is your help and the one who sustains you. Please pray for the services this weekend. Pray that God will use Dave Drapecky to challenge and encourage our church. Also pray the fathers would feel honored and loved!
