## HOME WITH THE LORD

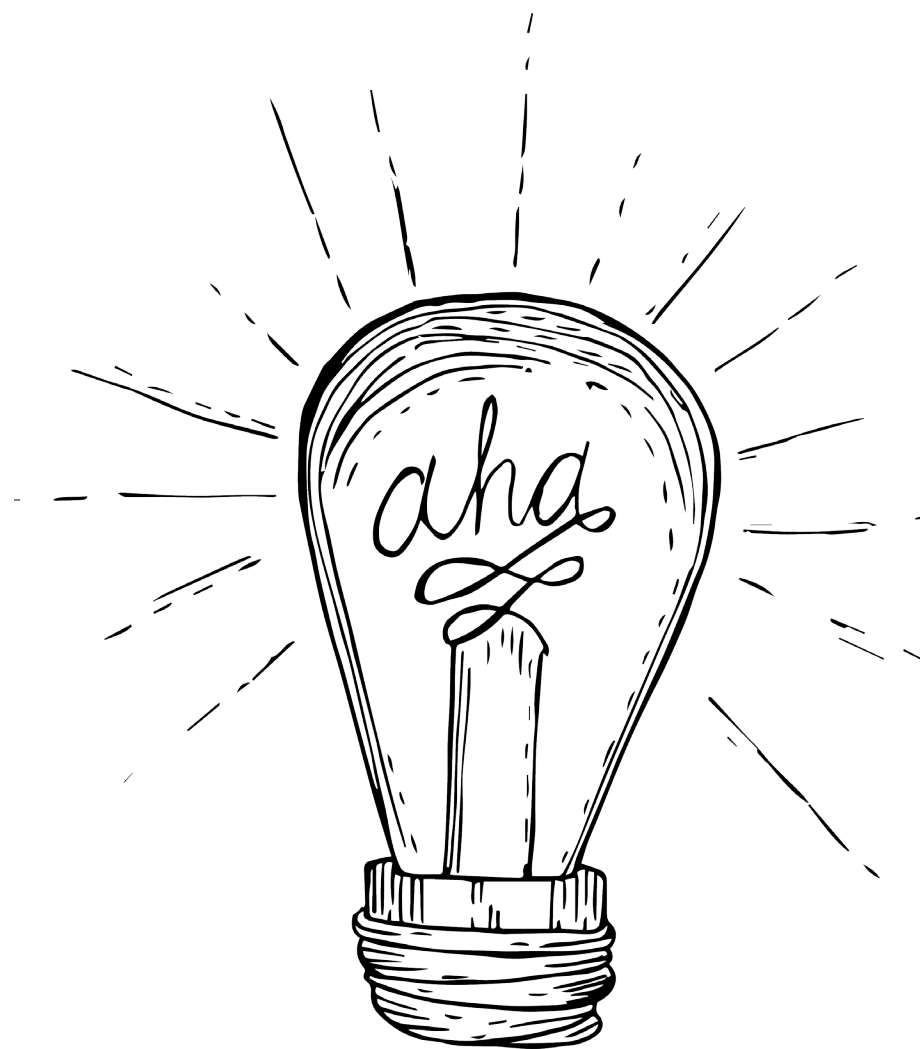

# DAILY MEDITATIONS

## MONDAY

Please read Romans 10:13. What encouraged you in last weekend's sermon? Recall the first time you realized that God wanted to have a personal relationship with you. *Thank God today for His love for you. Thank Him for the peace He gives - not just peace for living but eternal peace in Him.*

## TUESDAY

For the rest of this week we're going to read different passages about salvation and reflect on God's work in our lives. Please read Ephesians 2:8-9. What does this passage teach you about salvation? How does this encourage you today? *Thank God today that He has saved you completely and totally by His grace. Pray that you will grow in your desire to be in relationship with God and that you'll be willing to share with others!*

## WEDNESDAY

Please read Luke 7:36-50. What does this passage tell you about salvation? How does this encourage you today? *Thank God today that He saves us right where we are. Thank Him for His mercy. Pray for a heart that lives in gratitude.*

## THURSDAY

Please read Romans 3:21-24. What does this passage tell you about salvation? How does this encourage you today? *Thank God today that no matter what your sins, God's salvation is greater. Ask God for a heart that longs to grow in daily holiness and grow closer to Him.*

## FRIDAY

Please read Acts 4:11-12. What does this passage tell you about salvation? How does this encourage you today? *Thank God today for the simplicity of our faith. Pray that God will help you keep your faith simple and focused on Him and His grace.*

## SATURDAY

Please read Lamentations 3:19-23. Thank God today for His unending compassion and love for you. Pray for a heart and mind that choose to live in God's peace and mercy instead of your own strength. Please pray for the services this weekend. Pray that Albert Tate will be a blessing to our church and that people will come ready to learn and grow!
