“(God said to Moses...) So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt.” Exodus 3:10

EXCUSE #1 : _____

“But Moses said to God, ‘**Who am I** that I should go to Pharaoh.’” Exodus 3:11

God’s Answer: _____

“And God said, ‘I will be with you...’” Exodus 3:12

“‘Surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.’” Matthew 28:20

EXCUSE #2 : _____

“Moses said to God, ‘Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they ask me, ‘What’s his name?’ Then **what shall I tell them?**’” Exodus 3:13

God’s Answer: _____

“Say to the Israelites, ‘**I am** has sent me to you....’” Exodus 3:14

“‘The Lord, the God of your fathers...has sent me to you...’” Exodus 3:15

“Say to them, ‘The LORD appeared to me...’” Exodus 3:16

“We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard...” 1 John 1:3

“**What if** they do not believe me or listen to me and what if they say, ‘The LORD did not appear to you!’?” Exodus 4:1

EXCUSE #4 : _____

“Moses said to the Lord, ‘O LORD, **I have never been eloquent**, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant.’” Exodus 4:10

God’s Answer: _____

“The Lord said to him, ‘Who gave man his mouth? Who makes him deaf or mute? Who gives him sight or makes him blind Is it not I, the Lord? Now go; **I will help you** speak and will teach you what to say.’” Exodus 4:11

“(Jesus said)... Do not worry about how you will defend yourselves or what you will say... For the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say.” Luke 12:11-12

“‘O Lord! Please send someone else to do it!’” Exodus 4:13
