When he came to the village of Nazareth, his boyhood home, he went as
usual to the synagogue on the Sabbath and stood up to read the Scriptures.
The scroll of Isaiah the prophet was handed to him. He unrolled the scroll
and found the place where this was written: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon
me, for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me
to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the
oppressed will be set free, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come."
Luke 4:16-19 NLT

Jesus says he brings Good News four ways. He came to:

1.	Release	

"...captives will be released..."

(Jesus said) "Everyone who sins is a **slave of sin**... But if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." John 8:34,36 NIV

2. Reveal _____

"...the blind will see ... "

(Jesus said) "Anyone who has **seen me** has **seen the Father**!" John 14:9 NLT (See John 8:12)

3.	Relieve		
	"the oppressed will be set free"		
	(Jesus said) "The teachers of religious law and the Phariseescrush people with unbearable religious demands and never lift a finger to ease the burden." Matthew 23:2a,4
