FOUR MISTAKES WHEN PLANNING MY LIFE

Mistake #1: I overestimate my _____

Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? James 14:13,14a NLT
