### The two kingdoms collide the day of Christ's death...

#### Scene 1: Arrest

Just as he was speaking, **Judas**, one of the Twelve, appeared. With him was **a crowd armed with swords and clubs**... Then one of those standing near **drew his sword** and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear. "**Am I leading a rebellion**," said Jesus, "that you have come out with swords and clubs to capture me?" *Mark* 14:43,47,48

#### Scene 2: Trial

And they began to accuse him, saying, "We have found this man **subverting our nation**. He opposes payment of taxes to Caesar and **claims to be Christ, a king**." *Luke 23:2* 

- "Are you the king of the Jews?" asked Pilate. "Yes, it is as you say," Jesus replied. *Mark* 15:2
- "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest... my kingdom is from another place." *John 18:36*

#### Scene 3: Death

The written notice of **the charge against Jesus read: "The King of the Jews."** *Mark 15:26*
