Mormon Claims

Mormon Claims

The Growth of the Church

- Over 100 million copies of the Book of Mormon, in 100 languages
- 2000: 11 million members; for the first time, more than 50% are non-English speakers
- 2015: 15.3 million members




Early 19th Century

- Westward expansion (Louisiana Purchase 1803)
- New religious sects (Shakers, Oneida Community)
- Second Great Awakening (Charles Finney, Methodist Circuit riders, Revivals)
- Restoration Movement (Alexander Campbell)

Early 19th Century

- Denominational competition and bickering over doctrinal issues (baptism of infants, mode of baptism, predestination, etc.)
- Superstitious or "magical" worldview (magic peep stones, divination, spirits, etc.)
- Speculation and curiosity about the origin of the Indians. (A View of the Hebrews)







BOOK OF MORMON:

AN ACCOUNT WRITTEN BY THE HAND OF MOR-MON, UPON PLATES TAKEN FROM THE PLATES OF NEPHL

Wherefore it is an abridgment of the Record of the People of Nephi; and also of the Lamanites, written to the Lamanites, which are a remnant of the Home of Israel; and also to Jew and Gentile; written by way of commandment, and also by the spirit of Peoplesy and of Revelation. Written, and scaled up, and hid up into the Long, that they might not be destroyed, to come forth by the gift and power of Gon unto the interpretation thereof, scaled by the hand of Moroni, and hid up unto the Long, to come forth in due time by this way of Gentile; the interpretation thereof by the gift of Gon; an abridgment taken from the Book of Ether.

Also, which is a Record of the People of Jared, which were scattered at the time the Lorin confounded the language of the people when they were building a tower to get to Heaven; which is to show into the remnant of the House of Israel how great things the Lorin both done for their fathers; and that they may know the covenants of the Lorin, that they are not east off ferever; and also to the convincing of the Jew and Gentile that Jesus is the Christy, the ETERNAL God, manifesting Himself unto all nations. And now if there be fault, it be the mistake of min; wherefore coodern not the things of God, that ye may be found spotless at the judgment scat of Christy.



- 1830 Book of Mormon founded, Church established.
- 1831 Church moved to Kirtland, Ohio
- 1835 Book of Abraham papyrus acquired
- 1838 Church moved to Jackson Co., MO

- 1839 Church moved to Nauvoo, IL
- 1839-1844 Period of membership growth and doctrinal development.
- 1844 Death of Joseph Smith



Death of Joseph Smith 1844

- 1844 Church division over leadership of the community
- 1845 Westward migration
- 1847 Founding of Salt Lake City in the Utah territory. "This is the place."

- 1890 President Wilson ends polygamy
- 1978 President Kimball opens priesthood to blacks
- 2000 Membership reaches 11 million, with 50% outside of the United States


